## **INTRODUCTION**

This is the quarterly Cargo and Shipping Executive Report, covering the January to June quarter (Q4) of the 2016–17 financial year. This edition includes statistics on commercial and noncommercial consignments, vessels, containers, and post quarantine detections.

## **DEFINITIONS**

Noncompliance	Imported goods (including food), containers or international vessels that do not comply with the Department of Agriculture and Water Resources requirements or directions
Intervention point	When imported goods, containers or international vessels are subject to intervention before entry into Australia


### **COMMERCIAL CONSIGNMENTS**

**Noncompliance rates** – proportion of commercial consignments referred to the Department (full import declarations and long form self-assessed clearances) having one or more noncompliant directions or Automatic Entry Processing (AEP) results in the Agriculture Import Management System (AIMS).

**Physical intervention rates** – proportion of consignments referred to the Department that were inspected, treated, exported or destroyed.



#### Volume, intervention and noncompliance rates




### NONCOMMERCIAL CONSIGNMENTS<sup>2</sup>

**Noncompliance rates –** proportion of noncommercial consignments referred to the department that require further action, with the exception of inspection and release

**Physical intervention rates –** proportion of noncommercial consignments referred to the department that were inspected, treated, exported or destroyed in either the Self Assessed Clearance system (SAC) or AIMS.





### **Physical intervention directions**




## SEA CONTAINERS<sup>4</sup>

The department inspects the external surfaces of imported sea containers as they leave the wharf gates (WG). In addition, targeted on wharf inspections are performed for containers from particular countries on the Country Action List (CAL). CAL countries are identified due to particular unique risks such as 'Giant African Snail'.

Noncompliance rates - proportion of containers with low or high level biosecurity risk material detected during a WG or CAL inspection.



# INTERNATIONAL VESSELS<sup>5</sup>


Vessel voyage - One or more consecutive visits to an Australian port after travelling in international waters..

**Failure rates** – For VMS data, the proportion of vessel voyages that contained an inspection result of 'Fail'. For MARS data, the proportion of vessel voyages that contained an inspection that resulted in 10 or more demerit points being applied.

**Inspection rates** – For VMS data, the proportion of vessel voyages that contained an inspection result of 'Fail', 'Non conformity' or 'Pass'. It excludes inspections with the result of 'Noninspect' or 'No result'. For MARS data, the proportion of vessel voyages that contained a completed inspection.





Volumes, inspection and failure rates for vessel voyages in  ${\bf Q4^8}.$ 




